The Annual Meeting of the members of Kandiyohi Power Cooperative (KPC) was held by conference call due to COVID-19, with no membership in attendance on the 21st day of April 2020 pursuant to the notice mailed to every registered member of the Cooperative residing in Districts 1, 2 & 3.
